"SAM"ANTICS

"But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us." (2 Corinthians 4:7)

2 Corinthians 4 begins with a section devoted to the Gospel. Paul writes of how inspired men share the message of salvation (Romans 1:16) while, at the same time, recognize their imperfections. In verse 7 he reminds us all that the power, the glory, and the perfection of the gospel is a **"treasure"** entrusted to **"earthen vessels"**.

Such **"earthen vessels"** were the cheapest and most fragile utensils in use during the time. It isn't that Paul wants us to feel cheap and inconsequential, it is that he wants us to realize that the gospel has the power to do for us what we cannot do for ourselves. What saves us is greater than us and our imperfections. We can rejoice that God has placed such a trust in our frail hands; but we have no room to boast about how much we deserve that trust.

The original readers of this letter had lived grossly imperfect lives (1 Corinthians 6:9-11), yet God had erased their past and now depended on them to tell the story of saving grace (by word and by example). It is not really any different today! The gospel outshines us all, and yet we frail vessels of clay are His choice to get the message out to a world needing what we have already found. Be grateful that He trusts you with this treasure, but never boast in self; only the cross (Galatians 6:14).
